

Congratulations!!!

On being the winning bidder for the one week yachting experience aboard the "Toy Box"! You will be accompanied by a captain and first mate, who have their own quarters. All fuel will be paid by the donor.

This beautiful vessel is 78.4 feet long and 21 feet wide. It has a master stateroom complete with 2 full bathrooms. There are 2 additional staterooms with private bathrooms. There is also sleeping accommodations for 2 in the pilot house. The boat has spacious back deck entertainment area, a large living room with entertainment center and spacious well equipped galley.

Current toys aboard include a new upper deck hot tub, 2 kayaks, six scuba tanks and a compressor, and a six person dingy.

A perfect boat trip might include stops at the famous Semiahmoo Golf and Country Club and the Loomis Trail Golf course in Blaine, Washington. This resort also has excellent spa facilities and restaurants. After finishing a round of golf on Saturday pm and another on Sunday am, the boat would leave for Suchia Island. Here the crabbing is good and there are island trails and beach excursions that can fill your day. Anchor out and the next day head for Friday Harbour (San Quan Island) for a day visit. From there, go on your own private whale watching excursion ending up at Roche Harbour for the night. This quiet anchorage comes equipped with fine on shore restaurants and a walk to the Mausoleum is a must. Tuesday head out for Victoria for a day of shopping and sight-seeing (and for the golfers you have a choice of Cordova Bay, Bear Mountain, Or Olympia). Wednesday, either golf again before you leave port or just leave and head up to Poet's



Cove at Bedwell Harbour. This fine resort has a pool and great restaurant. On Thursday, head over to Ganges Harbour. This is a great little town on Saltspring Island that is an artistic community with several shops and restaurants (and a golf course). Either stay here on Thursday night or go a short distance to Montague Harbour and anchor out. If you're at Montague, you might want to go and eat at the Galiano Inn (this is the best restaurant in the gulf islands). Friday would unfortunately come too soon and back to Vancouver you go.

"Toy Box" is equipped with stabilizers and provides very comfortable cruising under most conditions.
